
The Muslims began traveling to Medina, and the Prophet, peace be upon him, waited for Allah's permission to leave Mecca.










They began preparing for their

Quraysh disbelievers.



the disbelievers.




As a result, the disbelievers would not expect them to take a different path, since they were guarding the route to Medina to prevent their escape and kill him.




The Prophet, peace be upon him,

be upon him.






During the journey, Abu Bakr protected the Prophet, peace be upon him, like a loyal guard and served him with great love until they arrived safely in Medina.






After the Prophet, peace be upon

Allah, peace be upon him.






Abu Bakr became the caliph of the Muslims and their new leader, the first of the Rightly Guided Caliphs.


He managed to save the first Islamic state with his wisdom, courage, and deep love for Allah and His Messenger, peace be upon him.
