





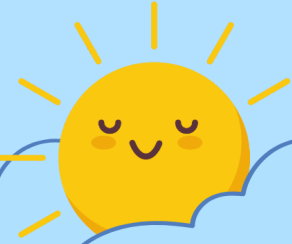




Ali, may Allah be pleased with him,

and the Muslims.




Ali married Fatimah, the daughter

be upon him.




Ali loved the Prophet, peace be upon him, deeply and would sacrifice himself for him.






When the disbelievers of Quraysh

in his house.






The disbelievers of Quraysh were lying in wait to kill the Prophet in his bed, but when they found Ali instead, they were furious.

Ali's bravery in this instance made him the first to sacrifice himself for the Prophet in Islam.




The Prophet, peace be upon him,

upon him, to their owners.




People would leave their valuables

to Madinah.




In Madinah, Ali became one of the

the Islamic state.








This was a time of significant challenges and conspiracies from the enemies of Islam.
