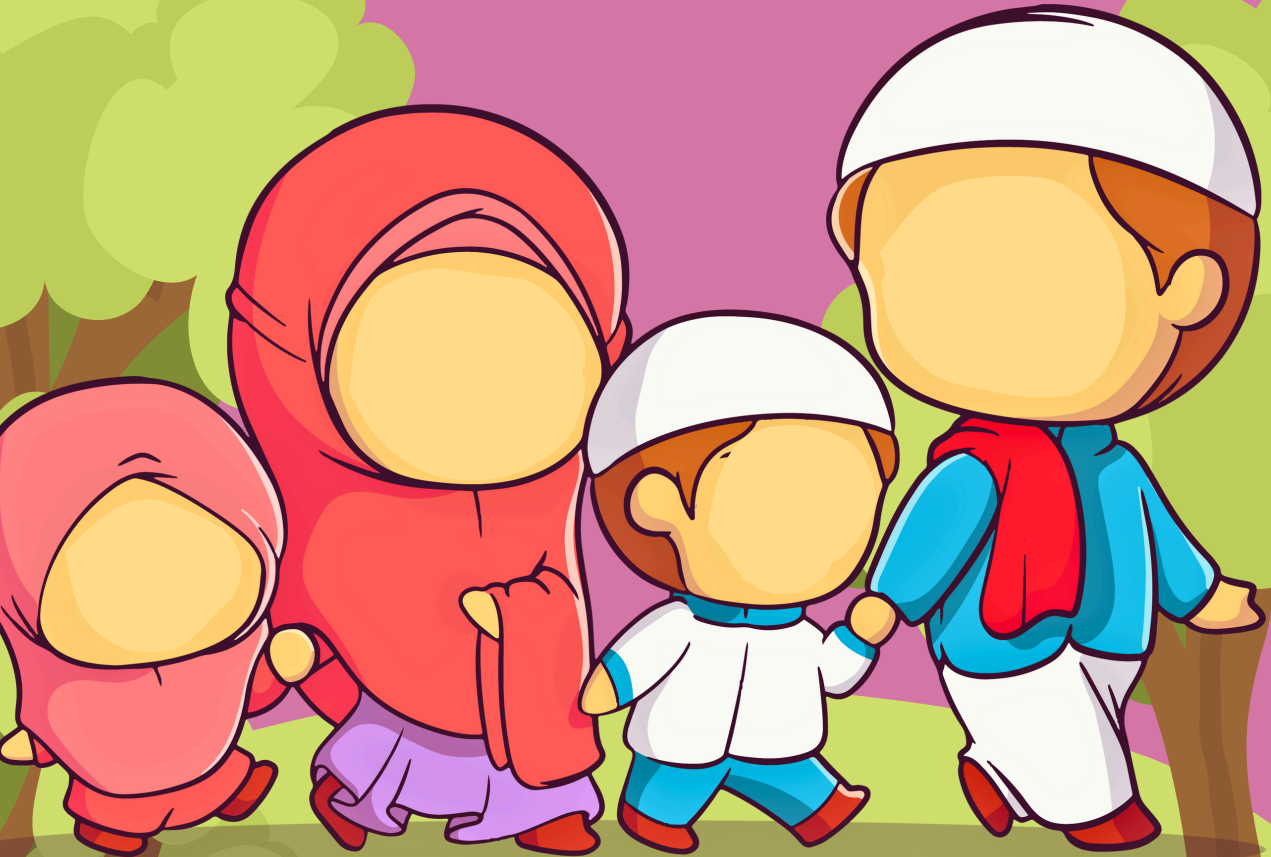

STORY COLLECTION



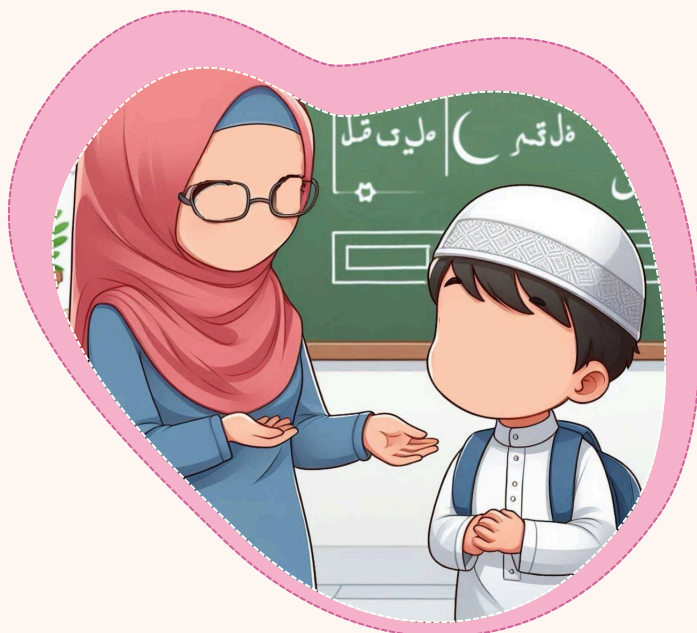


Khalid entered his school feeling very happy because he would meet his friends after the summer vacation.

Then the teacher approached Khalid and gently said to him: "Where is the Islamic greeting, Khalid?"

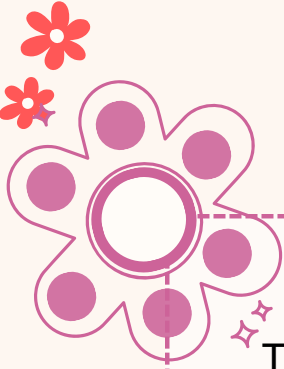
Have you so quickly forgotten what we learned about the etiquette of greeting?"

Khalid replied: "We say:

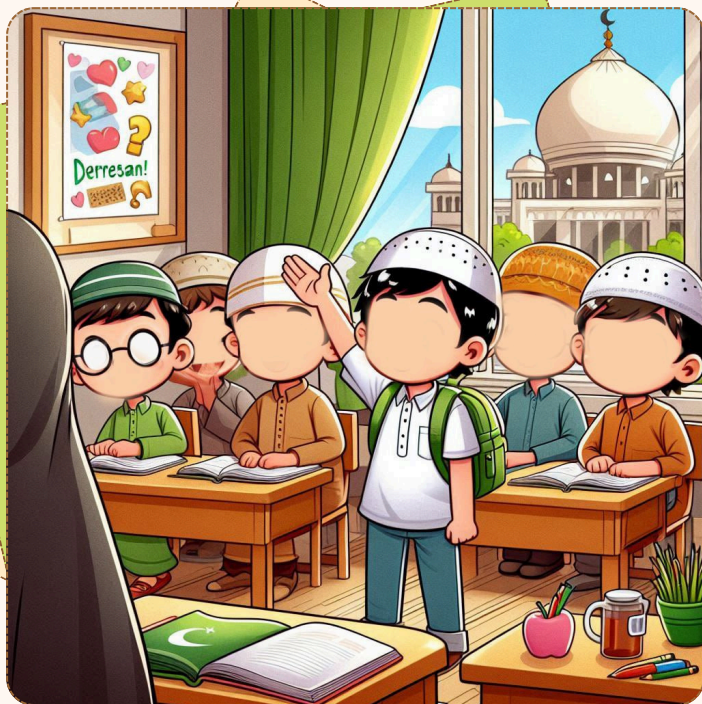
*As-salaamu alaykum*
