THE DAY OF 'ARAFAH IS SACRED TO MUSLIMS,
FALLING ON THE 9TH OF DHUL HIJJAH, THE DAY
BEFORE EID-AL-ADHA.

ON THIS DAY,

PILGRIMS TAKING PART IN HAJJ STAND BEFORE ALLAH AT ARAFAT FOR LONG PERIODS OF TIME, OFFERING SUPPLICATIONS AND PLEADING FOR HIS MERCY.

MUSLIMS WHO AREN'T UNDERTAKING PILGRIMAGE INCREASE THEIR ACTS OF WORSHIP, SEEKING FORGIVENESS AND MERCY FROM ALLAH.

SCHEDULE FOR THIS DAY:

1

Retire early the night before to gather strength for worship.

2

Rise before dawn to partake in suhur, intending to fast.

3

Then offer at least two or four units of prayer, and in prostration, beseech Allah for the best of this world and the Hereafter

4

Before dawn, seek your Lord's forgiveness, that you may be recorded among those who seek forgiveness before dawn.

5

Prepare for the Fajr prayer a few minutes before the call to prayer.

6

Perform the Fajr prayer, then remain in devotion until fifteen minutes after sunrise.

7

Begin proclaiming the Takbeer (Allah Akbar) immediately after the concluding salutation:
Allahu Akbar, Allahu Akbar, La ilaha illa Allah; Allahu Akbar, Allahu Akbar, wa lillahil-hamd.

SCHEDULE FOR THIS DAY:

8

8. Remain until sunrise, reciting the Qur'an, glorifying Allah, declaring His oneness, praising Him, invoking blessings upon the Prophet ﷺ, and engaging in the morning supplications.

9

You now have a choice: if you are able to stay awake, then do not let a single moment slip by without remembrance and supplication; or, rest for an hour with the intention of regaining strength for continued worship.

10

Upon waking, perform ablution, offer the Duha prayer, and engage in varied acts of devotion.

Frequently recite: "La ilaha illa Allah, wahdahu la sharika lah, lahul-mulk wa lahul-hamd, wa huwa 'ala kulli shay'in qadeer."

11

Perform the Dhuhur prayer, magnify Allah with Takbeer (allah akbar), glorify Him with Tasbeeh (subhan allah), and recite the Qur'an.

12

Offer the 'Asr prayer, proclaim the Takbeer, and recite the evening remembrances.

SCHEDULE FOR THIS DAY:

13

Continue reading the Qur'an until an hour before Maghrib, then begin your supplications with deep humility—ask Allah for every noble need of this world and the Hereafter, and do not forget to pray for your fellow Muslims.

14

Implore Allah that the sun of 'Arafah does not set except that you are counted among those whom He has freed from the Fire.
