

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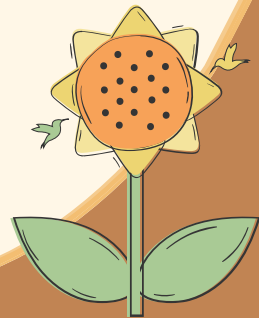


# HUD


PEACE BE UPON HIM



In ancient times, the prophet Hud was the messenger sent by Allah to his disbelieving people.

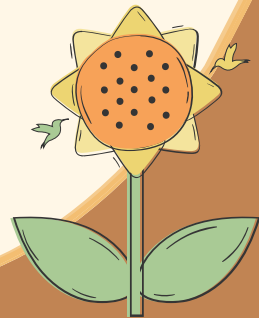
Their city thrived with trade and prosperity, but it was also a city overrun with corruption and injustice.








Hud's people were the first to

sins without fear.





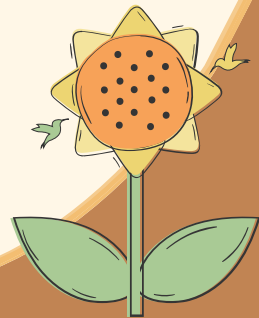


Hud was a courageous and patient man, carrying in his heart the love of








Allah, the love of His message, and

of worthless and useless idols.






He said to his people with all sincerity and admonition, "O my people, worship Allah alone; you have no other god but Him. Don't worship idols that neither benefit nor harm you."





These idols are created by humans and do not have the power to bring you harm or benefit.

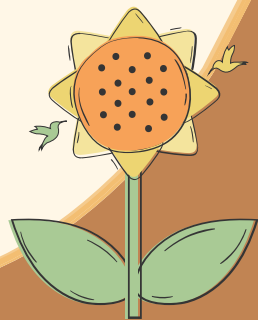



Leave this and support Allah and His messenger and follow them."

They said, "O Hud, do you come to us with your message to prevent us from worshipping our gods, whom






our ancestors used to worship and rely upon? We know no god other than them, and we cannot abandon the traditions of our forefathers that we live by."



 The disbelief and stubbornness of  Hud's people continued until Allah's anger befell them, and His command came to punish them for their








arrogance, tyranny, and

in its path.









These winds destroyed all that lay before them, demolished the houses of the wrongdoers, and caused havoc everywhere by Allah's command.




However, those who believed in Allah and His messenger, followed Hud, forbade corruption, and enjoined good were saved by Allah and protected from the punishment.

right path.



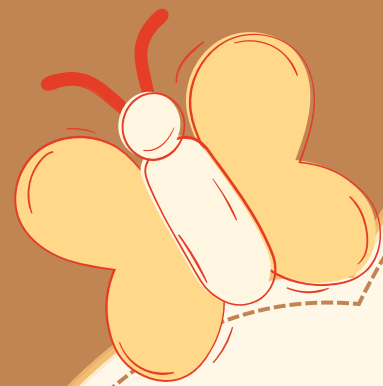
We also learn that the consequence

punishment and wrath of Allah.



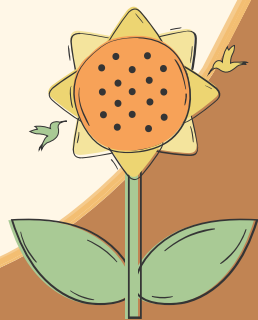
Accepting and following Allah's message, which came to us through His messengers, is the straight path that Allah approves of, and those who follow it are showered with His mercy, guidance, and victory.
