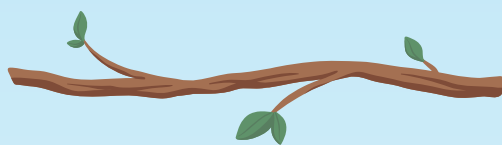


My Creed

Introduction



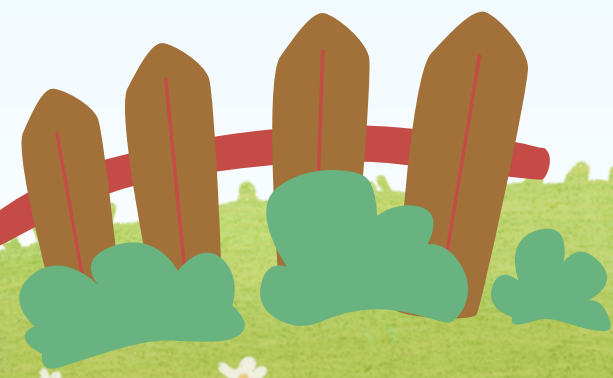
