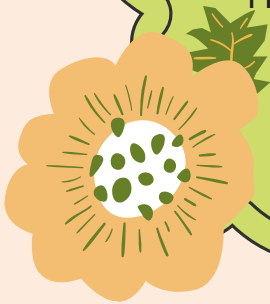


She stood by the Muslims from the beginning of Islam, enduring the persecution of the Quraysh disbelievers.



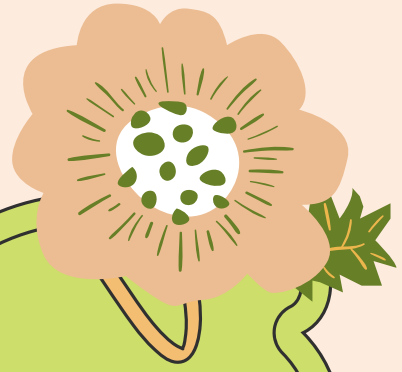
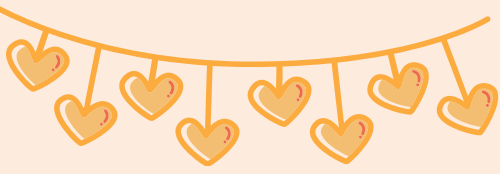


The most difficult moment for her was the killing of her brother Hamza (may Allah be pleased with him) in the Battle of Uhud.

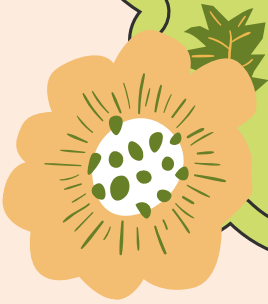


She bore this loss with patience and sought reward from Allah, acknowledging Hamza as the leader of the martyrs.



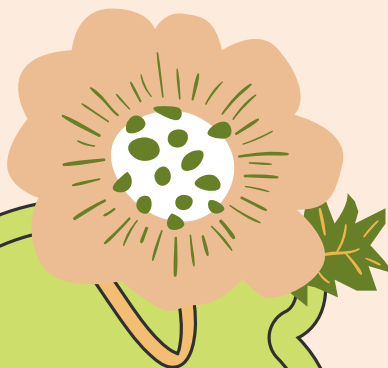


Safiyyah was proud of her Islam

(peace be upon him).



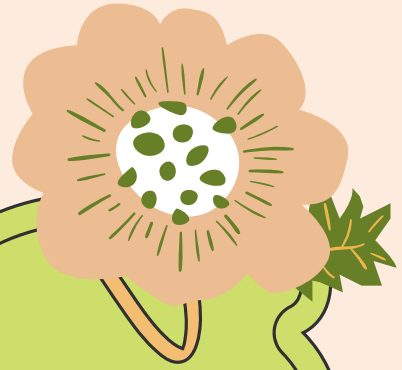
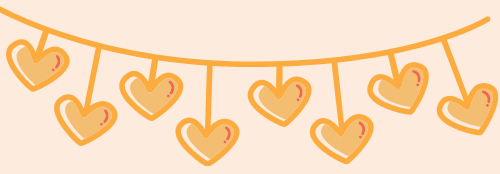


During the Battle of the Trench, when the disbelievers gathered in armies to besiege Medina (the city of the Muslims),



the Prophet (peace be upon him) ordered the women to be protected in a fortress away from the eyes of the disbelievers, allowing the men to confront the enemy armies.



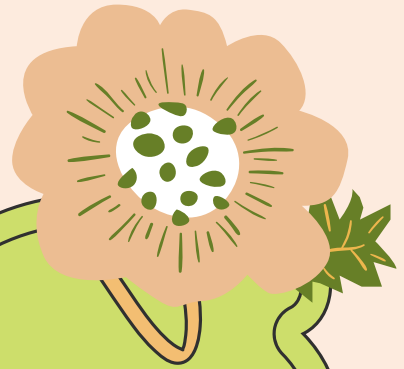
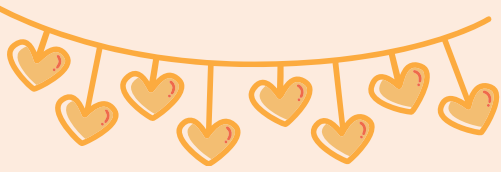


However, a Jewish spy infiltrated

Safiyah noticed his movement;
she was vigilant to protect the fort;



she seized an opportunity, striking
the spy suddenly and killing him,
thus protecting the Muslims
from his harm.



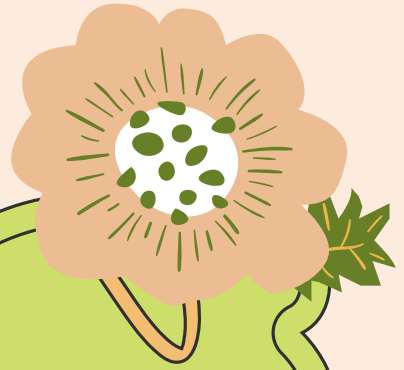
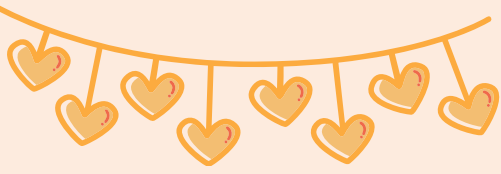


Safiyyah was a brave Muslim woman who would not allow a spy to threaten the women's safety while the men were preoccupied with fighting the disbeliever armies.



The Muslims achieved victory in this battle, known as the Battle of the Trench (Ghazwat al-Khandaq) or the Battle of the Confederates (Ghazwat al-Ahzab).



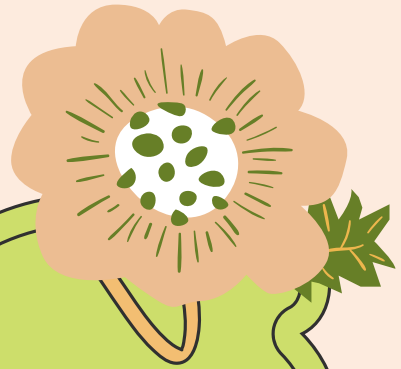
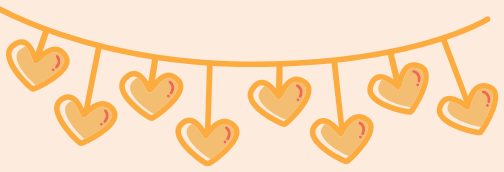


It was called the Battle of the Trench because the companions dug a large trench around Medina to prevent the disbeliever armies from entering.



It was also called the Battle of the Confederates because the disbelievers from various places gathered as confederates to destroy the Islamic state in Medina.





However, Allah disgraced and defeated them, granting victory to the Muslims.



Safiyyah ensured the safety of the Muslim women through her vigilance and by dealing with a malicious spy who intended to harm them.
