favor from Allah.

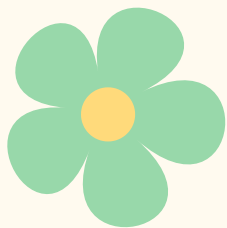




Allah commanded him to give one dinar as a charity for every thousand dinars to the poor, but he refused.
